

## POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DETAILS

## The conditions of this Scholarship are:

- 1. The following information must be included with the applicant's submission to be eligible for the Scholarship:
  - Completed Application Form
  - Proof of Enrollment in a Secondary Institution
  - Proof of Academic Records/Grades From Last Completed Grade
  - 1000 Word Essay on the History of Unions
  - \*Please note that any missing information will automatically disqualify the applicant's submission from being eligible to apply for the Scholarship\*
- 2. The Scholarship is available to all CUPE Local 37 Active Members in Good Standing or their children.
- 3. The Local is awarding five scholarships per year of \$1500.00 each.
- 4. The recipient of the Scholarship must be prepared to show that they have been accepted as a full-time student to an approved institution of higher education such as a university, technological institute, college, etc. People who are currently attending post-secondary studies are eligible for this award.
- 5. The student must complete all application forms, which can be obtained from the CUPE Local 37 Union office during regular business hours, Monday to Thursday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m or from the website www.cupe37.ca.
- 6. The application forms, supporting documents, and the essay of approximately 1000 words on the history of Unions describing how unions came to be, the history to date, and some of the challenges unions face today must be submitted no later than August 31 of each year.
- 7. Essays must be typed, double-spaced on 8 ½" x 11" paper.
- 8. The selections and judging will be completed by the CUPE Education Division.
- 9. The awarding of the Scholarship will be based on the following principles:
  - The academic record of the student (proof is to be provided)
  - The 1000 word essay
  - Proof of acceptance in an institution of higher education
- 10. All decisions and awards are final.
- 11. All winners must have their picture taken with the President of CUPE Local 37 and allow it to be placed in our newsletter and on our website.
